Deze blijken in een grote behoefte te voorzien. Op deze eerste vier Talentendagen hebben meer dan **vijfhonderd** enthousiaste wetenschappers hun voordeel gedaan met de workshops en lezingen. In de workshops kwamen onder andere subsidie-aanvraag, publicatie in high-impact journals zoals Science, carrièreplanning, netwerken, projectmanagement en creatief werken aan bod.
